**Awards presentation and reception** will be in person on Friday, January 7th 6-8 pm at Gallery 50, Inc.

**Plein Air Exhibit** will take place from January 7th to January 28th at Gallery 50, Inc.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION:

1. Painters may capture any aspect of Cumberland County, but are limited to four(4) colors of their own choosing. Colors must be identified at time of check-in and solely used.
2. Canvases and papers will be stamped at time of check-in. Registered artists may paint, after check-in, until no later than 5 PM. Return work to Gallery 50 no later than 5:30 PM.
3. Canvases entered must be framed and works on paper matted and framed.
4. Two works may be submitted for exhibition.
5. Work must be picked up at Gallery 50 on Saturday, January 29, 2021 during regular gallery hours.
