Possible Recreation Grant Opportunities

Ms. Gauntt talked about two grant opportunities, Finish Line Youth Foundation and Kaboom. The next application period for Finish Line is July 1 – August 31, 2021. Unfortunately, Cumberland County is not considered an eligible community for the Kaboom grant but the list is updated regularly.
